- Artemisia californica - CA sagebrush, (E,S) 3-4', sun
- Aster chilensis,(P) 2-3', full/part sun, spreads by rhizomes
- Atriplex lentiformis - Quail/Salt Bush (E,S) 8', sun
- Baccharis pilularis - Coyote Brush (E,S) 3-6'tall, sun
- Brickellia californica - Brickelbush (D,P) 2', sun to part shade, fragrant
- Brodiaea californica (bulb),
- Calochortus - Mariposa Lily/Tulip Lily (bulb) 8-24",
- Carex pansa – sedge used to as a lawn alternative
- Ceanothus – (E,S), sun, larval host of Spring Azure butterfly & Common Sheep Moth
- Ceanothus (Cerastes) 'Blue Jeans', 6'x6', lavender
- Ceanothus - 'Julia Phelps', 8'
- Ceanothus - 'Wheeler Canyon'
- Cercocarpus betuloides - Mountain Mahogany (E,S)
- Coreopsis gigantea (summer D) 7-8',
- Dichelostemma ida-maia - Firecracker Flower (bulb), sun/part shade
- Diplacus (Mimulus) bifidus (P) part shade
- Eriogonum fasciculatus - CA Buckwheat (E,S) 3x3', sun/part sun
- Eriogonum grande rubescens - Red Buckwheat (E,P), 1-2'h, 3-4'w, sun/part sun
- Fremontodendron californica - Flannel Bush 'Ken Taylor', (E,S) sandy soil, sun,
- Galvesia speciosa - Island Snapdragon/ Firecracker (E,S), 2-4', sun/part shade, good under oaks
- Gnaphalium sp. (E,P) weedy look
- Grindelia hirsutula - Gum plant (P) 1-2', an excellent nectar plant
- Holodiscus discolor - Cream Bush, (D,S) part shade
- Lonicera interrupta - Chaparral Honeysuckle, full sun/shade
- Lupinus albifrons - Silver Bush Lupine (E,P) 3-5', full sun

Monardella villosa - Coyote Mint (P) 2', sun/part shade

Polypodium californicum - California Polypody (P, summer D) 1-2'

Ribes viburnifolium - (E) Currant, 8'wX2-3"h, shade

Salvia apiana – Bee Sage/White Sage, (E) 3-8', full sun

Salvia leucophylla - Purple Sage (E,S) 3-6' sun

Salvia leucophylla 'Bee's Bliss' (E,S) ground cover

Satureja douglasii - Yerba Buena (D,P) ground cover, shade

Sedum spathulifolium - Stonecrop

Trichostema lanatum - Woolly Blue Curls (E,S) 2-4'h, 3-4'w, full/sun-light shade

Triteleia bridgesii (bulb) shade

Natives - Occasional Water

Achillea millefolium - Common Yarrow

Aquilegia formosa - Western Columbine

Berberis aquifolium 'Compacta' - Mahonia, Oregon Grape (E,S) shade/part sun

Calycanthus occidentalis - Spice Bush (D,S) 3-8', sun to shade

Carpenteria californica 'Elizabeth' - Bush Anemone (E,S) 6-9', full/part sun

Cercis occidentalis - Redbud (D,T) 6-14', sun

Dendromecon harfordii - Island Bush Poppy, (E,S) 3-9', full/part sun,

Dendromecon rigida – Bush Poppy

Diplacus (Mimulus) aurantiacus - Sierra/Sticky Monkey Flower (E,P) 1-4' tall, part shade
larval host of Variable Checkerspot in early spring & Buckeye in late summer

Epilobium canum ssp. *canum* (Zauschneria) (P) - CA Fuchsia, <3', full sun,
Calistoga, Carmen's, Sierra Salmon

Eriogonum giganteum - St. Catherine's lace (E,S) 5'

Erysimum capitatum - Western Wallflower

Fragaria californica - Wood Strawberry, ground cover

Heuchera maxima - Alum Root, 30", shade

Iris douglasiana (EP) sun/part shade

Keckiella cordifolia - Climbing Penstemon (E,P) 3-6' sprawling, sun/part shade

Lepechinia hastata - Pitcher Sage (E,P) sun/pt sun

Lewisia cotyledon

Lonicera hispidula - California Honeysuckle (D,S) climbing, hummingbird flower

Philadelphus lewisii - Western Mock Orange (D,S) 6', sun/part shade, fragrant

Rhamnus californica - Coffee Berry (E,S)

Salvia brandegei - Brandegees Sage (E,S) 3', great for a butterfly garden, fragrant

Salvia mellifera - Black Sage (E,P) 3-6'h, 3-5'w, sun/partial sun

Salvia mellifera prostrata - Black Sage (E,P) sun

Salvia sonomensis - Sonoma Sage (E,P) low ground cover, light shade/sun

Salvia spathacea - Hummingbird Sage (E,P) part/full shade

Sambucus mexicana - Blue Elderberry (D,S)

Scrophularia californica - CA Figwort, Bee Plant, (P) 2 - 4', sun/part shade, clay soil, Chalcedon Checkerspot butterfly lives on this plant

Solanum xanti hoffmanni - Purple Nightshade, 2-3'

Vitis californica 'Roger's Red' - California Wild Grape (D,V)

Natives - Regular Water (1 week)

Aristolochia californica - CA Dutchman's Pipe, (D,V) sun/shade

Asarum caudatum - Wild Ginger (E,P), shade

Aster chilensis,(P) 2-3', full/part sun, spreads by rhizomes

Ceanothus griseus horizontalis - 'Carmel Creeper', 2'x10'w

Ceanothus gloriosus exaltatus 'Emily Brown' (E,S) ground cover, 1-2"hx4-6'w

Cornus sericea- Western Dogwood (D,S) 3-8', shade

Dicentra formosa - Western Bleeding Heart (P) shade

Garrya elliptica - SilkTassel (D,T)

Lepechinia fragrans - Wallace's Pitcher Plant (E,P) shade

Linum lewisii - Blue Flax (P) 2-3', full/part sun

Physocarpus capitatus - Nine Bark (D,S) 5'x6-10', part shade

Salvia azurea ssp. *pitcheri* (D,P)

Scirpus cernuus - Fiber-optic grass

Sisyrinchium bellum - Blue Eyed Grass (P), 4 - 12", sun/part shade

Solidago californica - CA Goldenrod (P) 1-4', sun/part shade

Natives – Wet (seep-bog-pond)

Helenium puberulum, (P) 2 – 3, sun, attracts a wide variety of insects including bees and butterflies

Horkelia cuneata puberula - Star Potentilla, (P) am sun / pm shade, sandy soil

Juncus effusus 'Spiralis' - Corkscrew rush (E) 10-18", sun/ part shade

Mimulus cardinalis - Scarlet Monkey Flower (D,P) 3', sun to shade, important Hummingbird flower

Mimulus guttatus - Seep Monkey Flower, (A/DP) 1-3'HxW, sun

Potentilla gracilis – Cinquefoil (P) 1', sun

Satureja mimuloides - A 1-3' perennial with deep red-orange 1-2" flowers, full sun, attractive to hummingbirds

Sidalcea malviflora - Checkerbloom (P) 6-24", sun/pt shade, no/mod water, (west of seep), larval host of West Coast Lady

Sisyrinchium californica - Yellow Eyed Grass (E,P) 8-12", sun, high water

Tellima grandiflora - Fringe Cup, shady

Natives – Annuals

Clarkia amoena - Farewell to Spring, 1-2' reseeds

Clarkia brewerii 8"

Clarkia concinna - Red Ribbons, 16", part shade, late spring, deep pink

Eschscholzia californica - CA Poppy, 1', sun, spring - summer (with water)

Gilia capitata - Globe Gilia 1-2', sun, mid spring to summer, blue

Limnanthes douglasii – Meadow Foam, sun/part shade, moist, spring, yellow

Linanthus grandiflorus - Mountain Phlox 18", sun or part shade, summer-fall, pale pink/white

Montia perfoliata - Miner's Lettuce

Nemophila maculata - Five Spot, 6", light shade summer, white

Phacelia tanacetifolia - Tansy Leaved Phacelia, 2', shade, summer, blue

Phacelia viscida 1-2', shade

Natives – Trees

Pinus sabiniana - Digger Pine

Quercus wislizenii – Interior Live Oak

Quercus lobata – Valley Oak
