

## Judy Schwartz and Rod Miller's Plant List, Oakland May 4, 2014

### Front Garage Side Driveway:

Wisteria and *Ceanothus griseus horizontalis* for erosion control (planted over a succulent that is not holding the hillside)

### Front Driveway Mail Box:

*Armeria maritima* (sea thrift), *Asarum caudatum* (wild ginger), *Blechnum spicant* (deer fern), *Claytonia sibirica*, *Clarkia*, *Collinsia heterophylla* (Chinese houses), *Eriogonum grande rubescens* (red buckwheat), *Eschscholzia californica* (California poppy), *Festuca californica* (California fescue), *Linum lewisii*, (flax), *Lupinus albifrons* (silver bush lupine), *Mimulus bifidus* (Monkeyflower), *Oxalis oregana* (redwood sorrel), *Penstemon heterophyllus* (foothill penstemon), *Salvia spathacea* (hummingbird sage), *Tellima grandiflora* (Fringe cups), *Woodwardia fimbriata* (giant chain fern)

**Shrubs:** *Ribes sanguineum*, *Rhamnus californica* 'Mound San Bruno' (coffeeberry)

**Trees:** *Pseudotsuga menziesii* (Douglas fir)

**Non-native plants** such as *Camelia*, *Cineraria*, *Columbine* hybrids, *Campanula* 'Dickinson Gold', *Dianthus*, *Franchoa sonchifolia*, *Geum coccineum*, *Heuchera* 'Stormy Seas', Maple tree, *Salvia*, *Viola* 'Etain'

### Front Driveway: (small area)

*Festuca californica* (California fescue), *Heuchera maxima*, *Polystichum munitum* (sword fern), *Ribes sanguineum*

**Non-native:** *Cineraria*, *Columbine* hybrids, Maple, and *Fuchsia*

### Lawn area sun:

*Arctostaphylos* 'Dr. Hurd', *Artemisia californica* (California sage), *Artemisia pycnocephala* 'Davids' Choice', *Aristolochia californica* (Dutchman's pipe), *Calycanthus occidentalis* (Spicebush), *Clarkia* varieties, *Epilobium canum* (California *Fuchsia*), *Erigeron glaucus* 'Wayne Roderick' (seaside daisy), *Eriogonum grande rubescens* (buckwheat), *Eschscholzia californica* (California poppy), *Lupinus albifrons* (silver bush lupine), *Penstemon heterophyllus* 'Blue Springs' and "Margarita" (foothill penstemon), *Salvia apiana* (white sage), *Salvia clevelandii*, *Verbena lilacina* 'De La Mina'

### Lawn area shade:

*Aquilegia formosa*, *Armeria maritima* (sea pink), *Asarum caudatum* (wild ginger), *Aster chilensis*, *Collinsia heterophylla* (Chinese houses), *Festuca californica* (California fescue), *Garrya elliptical* (silk tassel), *Heracleum lanatum* (cow parsnip), *Heuchera maxima*, *Lupinus arboreus* (yellow bush lupine), *Myrica californica* (Pacific wax myrtle), *Oxalis oregana* (redwood sorrel), *Polystichum munitum* (sword fern), *Prunus ilicifolia*, *Pseudotsuga menziesii* (Douglas fir), *Rhamnus californica* 'Mound San Bruno' (coffeeberry), *Ribes sanguineum* var. *glutinosum*, *Salvia sonomensis*, *Salvia spathaceae* (hummingbird sage), *Sambucus mexicana* (blue elderberry), *Satureja*

douglasii (Yerba buena), Sisyrinchium bellum 'Rocky Point' (blue eyed grass), Tellima grandiflora (Fringe cups), Woodwardia fimbriata (giant chain fern)

**Non-native:** Cuphea sp Minnie Mouse

**Side of house:**

Achillea millefolium "Island pink" (pink yarrow), Clarkia, Epilobium angustifolium (fireweed), Epilobium canum, Eriogonum grande rubescens (red buckwheat), Lupinus arboreus (yellow bush lupine), Monardella villosa (Coyote mint), Penstemon heterophyllus 'Blue Springs' and "Margarita" (foothill penstemon), Tolmiea menziesii (piggy back plant), Verbena lilacina 'De La Mina', Viola adunca,

**Non-natives:** Bougainvillea, Fuchsia arborescens, Hydrangea, Lavandula dentata and stoechas (lavendar), Lorapetulum, Rose, Salvia, Tibouchina semidecandra (Princess flower)

**Back hillside sun natives:**

Achillea millefolium "Island pink" (pink yarrow), Arctostaphylos Emerald Carpet, Arctostaphylos 'Pacific Mist', Artemisia californica (coast sagebrush), Artemisia pycnocephala 'Davids' Choice', Asclepias fascicularis (narrow leaf milkweed), Aster chilensis 'Point Saint George' (aster), Clarkia varieties, Ceanothus concha, Ceanothus dark star, Ceanothus griseus horizontalis, Ceanothus hearstiorum, Epilobium canum (California Fuchsia), Erigeron glaucus (seaside daisy), Festuca idahoensis, Lupinus albifrons (silver lupine), Mimulus aurantiacus (monkeyflower), Monardella villosa (Coyote mint), Penstemon heterophyllus 'Blue Springs' and "Margarita" (foothill penstemon), Romneya coulteri (Matilija poopy), Salvia clevelandii, Salvia leucophylla, Salvia sonomensis, Sidalcea malvaeflora (checkerbloom), Vitis californica 'Roger's Red'

**Back hillside shade natives:**

Allium unifolium (native onion), Aquilegia formosa (columbine), Brodiaea elegans, Calycanthus occidentalis (Spicebush), Carpenteria californica, Chlorogalum pomeridianum (soap plant), Collinsea heterophylla (Chinese houses), Dichelostemma capitatum (blue dicks), Dicentra Formosa (bleeding heart), Festuca californica (California fescue), Gaultheria shallon (salal), Heracleum lanatum (cow parsnip), Heuchera hybrids from Santa Barbara Botanical garden: Canyon Melody, Canyon Delight, Pink Wave, Canyon Belle, Heuchera micrantha, Heuchera maxima, Heteromeles arbutifolia (toyon), Hierochloa occidentalis, Iris douglasiana, Lonicera hispidula (California honeysuckle), Liliium pardalinum (leopard lily), Lupinus albifrons (silver bush lupine), Mimulus aurantiacus, Myrica californica (Pacific wax myrtle), Polystichum munitum (sword fern), Prunus ilicifolia ssp lyonii (Catalina cherry), Quercus agrifolia (coast live oak), Phacelia Bolanderi, Polypodium californicum, Rhamnus californica 'Mound San Bruno' (coffeeberry), Ribes aureum, (golden currant), Ribes sanguineum, Ribes viburnifolium, Salvia spathaceae (hummingbird sage), Satureja douglasii (Yerba buena), Scrophularia californica (Bee plant), Symphoricarpos albus (snowberry), Tellima grandiflora (fringe cups), Viola adunca, Woodwardia fimbriata (giant chain fern)

**Backyard Non-natives:** Agrostemma githago "Mila", Centaurea gymnocarpa (Annie's), Festuca "Siskiyou Blue" (blue fescue), Geranium, Helicitrichon sempervirens (blue oat grass), Lychnis coronaria, Salvia microphylla (pink sage),

*Passiflora loefgrenii*, *caerulea* (vine), *Pitosporum undulatum* (tree), *Rubus pentalobus*, *Tanacetum ptarmiciflorum* (silver leaf), *Westringia 'Wynyabbie Gem'*

**Lowest back yard pathway natives:**

*Aster chilensis 'Purple Haze'*, *Gilia Tricolor*, *Mimulus gluttatus*, *Sedum spathulifolium* "Cape Blanco", *Woodwardia fimbriata* (under steps)

**Non-natives:** *Bartlettina sordida* (purple shrub), *Cerinthe major purpurascens*, *Delphinium*, *Digitalis* (foxglove), *Fuchsia boliviana 'Alba'*, *Hydrangea*, *Jasminum* (jasmine), *Lamium*, *Plectranthus ecklonii*

**Sunken garden natives:** *Aquilegia Formosa*, *Calycanthus occidentalis* (Spicebush), *Clarkia* varieties, *Claytonia sibirica*, *Heuchera micrantha*, *Polystichum munitum* (sword fern), *Ribes sanguineum*, *Viola adunca*

**Non-natives:** Alpine strawberry, *Cineraria*, *Digitalis* (foxglove), *Fuchsia thymifolia*, *Geranium*, *Helleborus*, *Lathyrus odoratus* (sweet pea), *Lunera annua*, *Moussoma elegans*, *Penstemon*, *Primula*, *Rose*, *Thymus serpyllum*, *Trachelium caeruleum*

**Edibles:**

Fruits: apricot, fig, fuji apple, Meyer lemon, plum, pluot

Berries: boysenberry, ollalieberry, raspberry, strawberry

Vegetables: seasonal vegetables

Herbs: rosemary, Italian parsley, oregano, mint, basil, thyme

**Non-native plants naturalized in the yard:**

*Campanula primulifolia*, *Clarkia* varieties, *Cineraria*, *Digitalis* (foxglove), *Eschscholzia californica* (California poppy), *Gilia Tricolor*, *Linaria Purpuria* (Toadflax), *Lunaria annua* (money plant), Santa Barbara daisies, *Nepeta faassenii* (catmint), and *Polystichum munitum* (sword fern)

Several varieties of *Mimulus aurantiacus* throughout the yard other than the usual orange color are *Mimulus aurantiacus* (cherry), *Mimulus bifidus* (white), *Mimulus gluttatus* (yellow), *Mimulus puniceus* (red),
