**General Planting Notes:**

All plants will need water through the first two years.

No pesticides..... Pick off buggies or spray with water.

None of the plants need pruning unless a shape is desired or a branch is getting in the way.

Perennials can be left through the winter, deadheading or shearing the grasses to 1/3 as desired.
