Ceanothus sp., California lilac		sun/part shade	Blue flowers early spring.	pollinators
Epilobium canum 'U.C. Hybrid', U.C. Hybrid California fuchsia	12-18" x 3'	full sun	Red-orange tubular flowers summer- fall. Spreads less than straight species.	hummingbirds
Eriogonum umbellatum var. polyanthum 'Shasta Sulphur', Shasta Sulphur Buckwheat	1/2 - 1-1/2' x 3-4'	full sun	Bright yellow flowers fade to gold.	butterflies, bees, birds
Iris Pacific Coast hybrids	1-3' x 1-3'	full sun, part sun	Various flower colors.	bees, birds
Juncus sp., Rush		full – part shade, clay tolerant.	Attractive brown seed heads, blue-green stems.	pollinators
Muhlenbergia rigens, Deer grass	4-5' x 4-6'	full sun	Spike like flowering stems arch above leaves.	pollinators
Nepeta x faassenii, Catmint	1-2' x 3-4'	full sun	Spring – summer lavender blue flowers, aromatic foliage.	pollinators
Oenothera californica, California Evening Primrose	4" x 12-30"	full sun	White, scented flowers bloom in evening. Dormant midsummer, emerges in late winter.	pollinators
Verbena lilacina 'De La Mina', De La Mina lilac verbena	2-3' x 3- 6'	full sun, fast growing	9 months of purple flowers.	butterflies, bees
